Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As your pastor, it is both an honor and a privilege to address you once again in this Annual Appeal letter. It has been a year filled with grace and gratitude, during which I have had the joy of serving this vibrant community, witnessing your unwavering commitment to our faith and the boundless generosity that flows from your hearts. Your contributions of time, talent, and treasure have allowed our parish to shine as a beacon of hope, extending our outreach to not only our own parishioners but also to those in need throughout our local community and beyond. It is with immense gratitude that we recognize the blessings God has given us, and I am excited as we continue to serve the Lord and His people together.

Certainly, much has been accomplished in our parish over the last year due to your support:

- We were able to fund our normal operations and ministries, and even had a surplus to add to savings;
- Over \$24,000 in second collections was raised to support charitable works both in the USA and abroad, as well as \$12,500 to build new public toilets for two schools in Rwanda, \$3,400 to purchase new shoes for children in Rwanda, and \$2,500 collected during Lent to feed and educate orphan children in Haiti.
- Our parish building fund raised over \$44,000 in collections, some of which was used to replace deteriorated window frames on the church (\$6,300), repair our sound system (\$1,500), as well as other necessary repairs, with excess available for future projects and repairs.

There is much to be proud of that has been made possible by you. And while I am most grateful for your generosity, your continued support is as important as ever. Our Annual Appeal is vital to operating our parish and solidifying its strong future. As we initiate our 2023-24 appeal, I invite you to prayerfully consider how you might contribute to the on-going mission of your parish, reflecting on how the Lord has blessed you and how we are called to invest some of those blessings in the continued work of His Church.
