Dear Parishioners,

Some time ago, I was at a gathering with some people I know from back home. In the course of the conversation I was sharing about some of the projects we have going on here at Holy Name, and as I was leaving, one of the men from the gathering got up and followed me. When we were out of earshot of the group, he very quietly gave me an envelope with a substantial donation for our parish. This man – who I will note is of limited means – has never been to our church, but when he heard about all that we have going on here, he wanted to make an investment in the mission of our parish.

Our mission: this is what guides and gives focus to all that we do. Jesus called His disciples to go out, teach all nations, and build up His kingdom, and that is what we continue to do: from the worship that takes place at our church, to the education that takes place at our school, and the support distributed by our SVDP Society and food pantry to those in need. More recently, we have been refreshing the old convent (the grey house in front of the school) for use as a social ministry center. It will now be called Emmaus House, recalling the encounter two of Jesus' disciples had with the Risen Lord as He accompanied them on their journey.

We remain grateful for your past investment in our parish, and ask for your continued investment in our mission. Both normal operations and extraordinary repairs (such as the need to replace an air conditioner unit this past summer) come with a cost, and your contributions to our parish are what make this possible. This annual appeal is our largest single source of financial support, and your donations to it are always used with careful discernment.

Here you find both a report of our stewardship this past year as well as a donation envelope for your offering to this year's annual appeal. As we look to the needs of the future, a strong financial position is a necessary foundation for ongoing development to serve both our parishioners and the community in which we live. Thank you as always for your prayers and support – in all of the forms these take.

Our Mission: Some Statistics

The mission of our parish, put simply, is to bring God to people and people to God. This cannot be easily quantified: only God knows how many souls are both introduced and brought closer to Him through the work of our parish. However, these are a few statistics that help to capture the impact of living out our mission.

- 43 young people received Baptism
- 40 children received First Penance and Holy Communion
- 20 candidates received Confirmation
- 5 couples were united in Holy Matrimony

Your support has also enabled us to provide for the Christian formation of our youth:

- 141 students were enrolled in Faith Formation
- 160 students were enrolled at Holy Name School

Your generosity has also been brought to our neighbors in need:

Our St. Vincent de Paul Society has given \$28,145 of support to the needy of our community, including \$1745 in grocery cards. Disbursements included assistance with rent, utility assistance, purchase of grocery cards, the Christmas Giving Program, twinning to other conferences within the district, and food pantry support.

Holy Name/Sacred Heart Food Pantry distributed food and clothing on 22,680 occasions – serving an average of about 436 people each week.
