St Francis Xavier Parish FY24 Financial Report

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

During this past fiscal year, we have continued to reduce our parish debt, restructured our parish support staff, implemented systems and processes to improve our efficiency and through your ongoing weekly tithing generosity continue to meet our annual operations expenses.

We used the proceeds from the sale of the Pine Street property to reduce our debt \$175,000 and to establish a Parish emergency fund of \$100,000.

We have also begun to implement our plan of action to progressively address our major infrastructure issues. During fiscal year 2024, in great part, thanks to your support of last year's annual appeal, we accomplished the addition of a four-unit columbarium to the cemetery, the rehabilitation and painting of the interior and exterior of St Francis Xavier Church and the repair of the parish office emergency exit.

Looking forward, we need to complete the identified upkeep projects to include handicap access to the church basement hall, re-siding the exterior and restoration of the interior of Sacred Heart Chapel, improved security lighting and sound systems, address the main floor of St Francis Church, add a bathroom to the Chapel and replace the fencing at St Patrick's Cemetery.

Shortly, we will be announcing our FY 25 Parish Appeal. Please keep an eye out for the Appeal information. We thank you in advance for your consideration and assistance in keeping our Parish infrastructure in good and safe state.
