Dear Parishioners,

A few weeks ago someone shared with me that a family member – who had been away from the regular practice of the faith for some time – had returned to regular worship at Mass. The reason? They had come to worship at our church, and were struck by the prayerful atmosphere and the palpable sense of God's presence here.

God is at work here – in so many ways. This report gives a snapshot of what God's grace has accomplished here this past year, including how we have been stewards of the financial support you have given us. Among other things, this has helped us to work on our physical plant. It might surprise you to learn that, until now, neither the church nor the rectory were insulated. Over the last several months we have been working with our energy suppliers to take advantage of incentive programs that will insulate both buildings at a small fraction of the regular cost. This will result in substantial savings in the future. We are also working on some physical improvements to the church which are funded by the ERC Tax Credit (a program resulting from the COVID shutdown).

We have also been working on a project that I know will be recognized as needed: on-site parking. Over the past year we have been working with an architect to create substantial parking areas – over 60 spaces – while preserving as much green space as possible. Along with this report you will find more information about this project.

This year's annual appeal will be entirely dedicated to supporting this next stage of our parish's development. Your past generosity has already given us a firm foundation with which to undertake this project, and your donation this year will further support this venture so that we won't need to take out a loan to see the project through to completion.

As we look to the needs of the future, something as simple as a parking lot will make our church more accessible and welcoming to those who come to worship with us. Thank you as always for your prayers and support – in the many forms that these take.

Our Mission: Some Statistics

The mission of our parish, put simply, is to bring God to people and people to God. This cannot be easily quantified: only God knows how many souls are both introduced and brought closer to Him through the work of our parish. However, these are a few statistics that help to capture the impact of living out our mission:

- 23 young people received Baptism
- 25 children received First Penance and Holy Communion
- 27 candidates received Confirmation
- 7 couples were united in Holy Matrimony

Your support also enables us to provide for the Christian formation of our youth:

- 109 students are enrolled in Faith Formation
- 195 students are enrolled at Holy Name School

Your generosity has also brought assistance to our neighbors in need:

Our St. Vincent de Paul Society has given \$24,874 of support to the needy of our community. Disbursements included assistance with rent, utility assistance, grocery cards, the Christmas Giving Program, twinning to other conferences within the district, and food pantry support.

Holy Name/Sacred Heart Food Pantry distributed food and clothing on 23,676 occasions – serving an average of about 455 people each week.
