



WHAT IS THE I AM HERE CAMPAIGN?

I AM HERE is a campaign begun by the [Archdiocese of Detroit](#) and [Hallow App](#) in support of the [National Eucharistic Revival](#). The Diocese of Fall River, along with other dioceses, have become partners in the I AM HERE campaign.

The goal of this campaign is to help parishioners encounter Jesus in the Eucharist and increase Eucharistic Adoration participation in your parish. We hope to do this by:

1. Sharing either the I AM HERE website iamhere.org or the Diocese of Fall River's I AM HERE landing page, which includes an interactive map to find Adoration in the diocese: www.fallriverfaithformation.org/iamhere
2. Inviting parishioners to share their stories with us and, by doing so, inspiring others to encounter Jesus in the Eucharist. Additionally, parishes can share Eucharistic testimonies on the I AM HERE site with parishioners in bulletins or social channels.
3. Promoting Eucharistic Adoration in parishes and providing resources for people to spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament

To help your parish increase Eucharistic Adoration participation, your parish can:

1. Request to receive **free** promotional materials ([brochures and banners](#)) that will help you make Eucharistic adoration more visible and approachable to your community.

2. Have a dedicated page in the iamhere.org website with all the Eucharistic testimonies submitted by your parishioners. See example [here](#).
3. Have access to free [audio meditations](#) offered by Hallow app to guide your parishioners, especially those who are not familiar with Eucharistic Adoration, pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament.

TOOLS TO COMMUNICATE THE DETAILS OF I AM HERE TO YOUR PARISHIONERS
